The Oswego County Office for the Aging has an immediate opening for an Aging Services Technician to assist in identifying participants in the coordination of case managed programs offered through the Office for the Aging (OFA). The incumbent promotes OFA programs and acts as an advocate and liaison for senior citizens and provides information and referral services to participants of all ages in the NY Connects Program.

**Qualifications:** Completion of 60 semester credit hours; **OR** Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and two (2) years of experience in a non-professional position supporting social service, health care, or other community-based programs providing assistance to the elderly. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** NYSOFA Options Counseling Certification required within one (1) year of appointment.

This title has been approved to be filled without the need to take an exam for a limited period through the HELP Program. Candidates appointed permanently to this title will NOT need to take an exam and will remain in their position even when the HELP Program ends.

**Pay Rate:** \$23.12 per hour plus competitive benefit package including: health, life, dental and vision insurance; NYS Retirement; and Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program.
