

OSWEGO COUNTY DRONE COORDINATOR

Oswego County will review applications/résumés for experienced drone pilots to manage the Unmanned Air Vehicle Systems (UAS) used by the County.

Minimum Qualifications: Possession of an associate degree and two (2) years of professional experience as a drone pilot*; OR Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and four (4) years of professional experience as a drone pilot*. *Qualifying experience as a drone pilot must include the following: Experience in managing small drone flight operations (FAA Part 107 capacity or FAA Certificate of Authority), heavy-lift drone operations (FAA Section 44807 capacity or equivalent) and/or aerial dispersal (FAA Part 137 capacity or equivalent), including developing drone permits and or waiver applications for approval by the FAA UAS Department of Integration. Understanding of FAA Parts 14 CFR Part 91, 14 CFR Part 135, 14CFR Part 137 & Section 44807 (49 U.S.C. 44807) Special Authority for Certain Unmanned Aircraft. SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Valid FAA Part 107 certification and valid FAA Drone Pro Certification at the time of appointment. Possession of a valid U.S. Driver's License at time of appointment, maintenance of license is required throughout the course of employment.
