

## OSWEGO COUNTY BUILDING AND GROUNDS SUPERINTENDENT

Oswego County will review applications for a Building and Grounds Superintendent to plan, coordinate, and administer the activities of the Oswego County Building and Grounds Department, making efficient use of personnel, equipment, and materials. This is highly technical, administrative, and engineering work involving responsibility for planning and carrying out the county's capital project renovation and building maintenance programs.

**Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree in construction or engineering technology or related field <u>and</u> six (6) years of experience in building maintenance, building repair, or construction, five (5) of which must have been in a supervisory and administrative capacity; OR associate's degree in construction or engineering technology or related field <u>and</u> eight (8) years of experience as described above, five (5) of which must have been in a supervisory and administrative capacity; OR graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma <u>and</u> ten (10) years of experience as described above, five (5) of which must have been in a supervisory and administrative capacity.

Appointment to the position is recommended by the County Administrator with approval of the County Legislature. Oswego County residency is required at time of appointment. Permanent appointment to this position requires successful completion of the civil service examination.
