Qualifications: Bachelor's degree in journalism, communications, marketing, public relations or closely related field; **OR** bachelor's degree including 15 credit hours in journalism, communications, marketing or public relations. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:** Possession of a valid New York State driver's license appropriate to the vehicles operated or otherwise demonstrate their ability to meet the transportation needs of the position. Position may require long-distance travel and occasional evening and weekend work.

Permanent appointment to this position requires successful completion of the civil service examination.
