The Oswego County Department of Community Development, Tourism and Planning has an immediate opening for a Planner. This is professional planning work involving responsibility for the preparation of plans and reports on a municipal, regional or community level. The work involves contact with public officials, professional and civic organizations and others representing the areas under study. The level and scope of work will vary depending upon the level of education and experience of the selected candidate.

Minimum Qualifications: Graduation from a regionally accredited or NYS registered college or university with a bachelor's degree in planning, environmental studies, geographic information systems, geography with a concentration in planning or closely related field. Higher level education and/or experience in municipal, community, or regional planning may qualify for a Senior or Associate level Planner title. Experience in grant writing and/or rural transportation systems planning and management preferred.

NOTE: Experience credited towards meeting the minimum qualifications may be derived from paid or volunteer work experience. Part-time experience will be pro-rated.

Permanent appointment to this position will require successful completion of the civil service examination.

2023 Pay Rates: \$24.96 to \$31.40 per hour contingent on qualifications (based on a 35 hour work week) plus competitive benefits package including: health, life, dental and vision insurance; NYS Retirement; and Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program.
