



OSWEGO COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATOR ASSISTANT (FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM)

The Oswego County Health Department has an immediate opening for a Public Health Educator Assistant under the Fellowship Program. This position involves responsibility for assisting in the planning, logistics, implementation, and evaluation of Emergency Preparedness and Public Health Education projects and Programs. Employee may prepare and gather necessary equipment and materials for vaccination or testing clinics, Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) drills and exercise or health education programs and outreach. In addition, incumbent will help review and update PHEP plans, and inventory grant purchased materials and equipment.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree; **OR** associate's degree and two (2) years of experience either in public relations or journalism or supporting health education programs; **OR** graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency diploma and four (4) years of experience as described above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Participation in Public Health emergency preparedness drills and responses may be required. Select immunizations may be required at time of appointment or at any time throughout the course of employment according to New York State Department of Health or other oversight agency requirements.

This is a temporary position funded by the Public Health Corps Fellowship program. Employees in the Public Health Fellowship program will earn a New York State Public Health Essentials certificate from Cornell University upon completion of the program.

Pay Rate: \$19.23 per hour plus competitive benefits package including: health, life, dental and vision insurance; NYS Retirement; and Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program.
