



## **OSWEGO COUNTY NURSE PRACTITIONER (PART-TIME)**

Oswego County will review applications/résumés for licensed Nurse Practitioners to provide psychiatric assessments of inmate patients at the Oswego County Correctional Facility. The Nurse Practitioner will establish and document appropriate diagnosis, treatment plan and strategy of care based on the individual assessment, and provides expert guidance and education when working with members of the Correctional Facility team.

**Qualifications:** Possession of a license and current registration to practice as a Nurse Practitioner in New York State in the \*specialty area(s) related to the work performed. \*Part 64 of the New York State Regulations of the Commissioner of Education defines the profession of Nurse Practitioners and includes the following specialty areas: Acute Care, Adult Health, College Health, Community Health, Family Health, Gerontology, Holistic Care, Neonatology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Oncology, Pediatrics, Palliative Care, Perinatology, Psychiatry, School Health, and Women's Health. **SPECIAL REQUIREMENT** - When prescribing medication is required: Pursuant to Title 8, Article 139, Section 6902 (3.a.ii) of New York State Education Law, candidate must complete not less than three semester hours or the equivalent in pharmacology in a nurse practitioner educational program registered by the New York State Education Department OR a program determined by the Department to be equivalent to a registered program. If successful, this certified privilege will be stated on the license received. **NOTE:** The specific requirements for certification for Nurse Practitioner positions are mandated under Title 8, Article 139, Section 6910 of New York State Education Law and Part 64 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education.
